The second letter must be from an unrelated person of your choice.
- 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average or higher
- The most recent official transcript in a sealed envelope <u>OR</u> emailed directly to scholarships@ipcdf.org from DePaul University with an official seal.
- Proof of all community service hours performed during the last 12 months.
