Scholarship recipients shall receive award checks after remitting proof of enrollment for the 2020-2021 academic year.

3. Complete one Scholarship Application. Check the box(es) on application for each of the scholarships for which you would like to be considered. Complete the entire application.
4. Write essay for scholarship(s) selected. The essay questions are in the individual scholarship descriptions. (Note- General Scholarship, HBCU Scholarship, and Graduate Scholarship all have the same essay question; therefore, only one essay is required if applying for two or more of these scholarships).
5. Include all documents required for the scholarship(s) that you are applying for in one packet. Review Scholarship Checklist to make a sure all require documents are included. (Note-no documents will be added to packet if sent separately.) An unofficial transcript is acceptable for application; however, if awarded a scholarship from IPCDF, an official transcript will be required before release of the scholarship award.
6. The recipients of the Dana G. Woodley, General, and HBCU Scholarships must attend a four-year college or university as a full-time student in the Fall of 2020.
