- Two letters of recommendation written during the current academic year (not dated before September 2020), addressed to IPCDF. One letter must be a character reference on official letterhead from a school official or a service organization with which you have volunteered. The second letter must be from an unrelated person of your choice.
- 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average or higher
- The most recent unofficial transcript
- Proof of all community service hours performed during the last 12 months
- A signed media release form

3. _____ Two recommendation letters written during the current academic year (not dated before September 2020)
 - One must be a character reference on official letterhead from a school official or a service organization with which you have volunteered
 - The second letter must be from an unrelated person of your choice

4. _____ A cumulative 3.0 Grade Point Average or higher

5. _____ The most recent unofficial transcript from DePaul University in a sealed envelope OR emailed directly to scholarships@ipcdf.org with an official seal

6. _____ Proof of all community service performed during the last 12 months
